Annual Goals

What progress has been made with respect to each goal?

1. Communications-

- Developed an IWIRC Florida network logo for use on letterhead and email communications.
- Created social media accounts (Facebook, Twitter, and Instagram) for publishing IWIRC content that is of interest to our membership.
- Created new committees for Social Media, Website, Newsletter, and Communications so that our Board members take an active role in facilitating communications to our membership.
- Created Florida Network pins in the shape of Florida for members to wear at networking events.

2. Planning-

- Added three new Board members (one for each region), and filled two empty Board positions. The five new members will serve a 2-year term beginning in 2019, which will allow the Florida Network to fill Board vacancies each year rather than every 2 years. By staggering our Board members, we will ensure that there is not a large turnover in Board membership thus keeping institutional knowledge of Board activities.
- Created a calendar of events to publicize activities throughout the state.
- Focus on overcoming our geographical challenges by maintaining Board positions in each region of the state, planning IWIRC events around regional meetings, and developing webinars for educational events.

3. Diversity of Events-

- The Florida Network Board meets monthly to discuss the planning of regional and state-wide events. As part of event planning, we look for events that include networking, career development, educational, and charitable opportunities.
- Partner with other organizations (i.e.- TMA and local bar organizations) and IWIRC Networks in planning joint events.

What assistance can IWIRC provide with respect to achieving each goal?

- Continue to publicize the great ideas from other networks.
- Encourage IWIRC leadership and Network leadership to visit local network events.
