The International Court of Justice (ICJ) is the primary judicial organ of the United Nations. Established in 1945 by the UN Charter, the ICJ began work in 1946 as the successor to the Permanent Court of International Justice. Since then, the ICJ has increasingly been used to solve cases involving international law. The ICJ has given judgment in famous cases such as the *Croatia v. Serbia* case (where application was made on the prevention and punishment of the crime of genocide).
