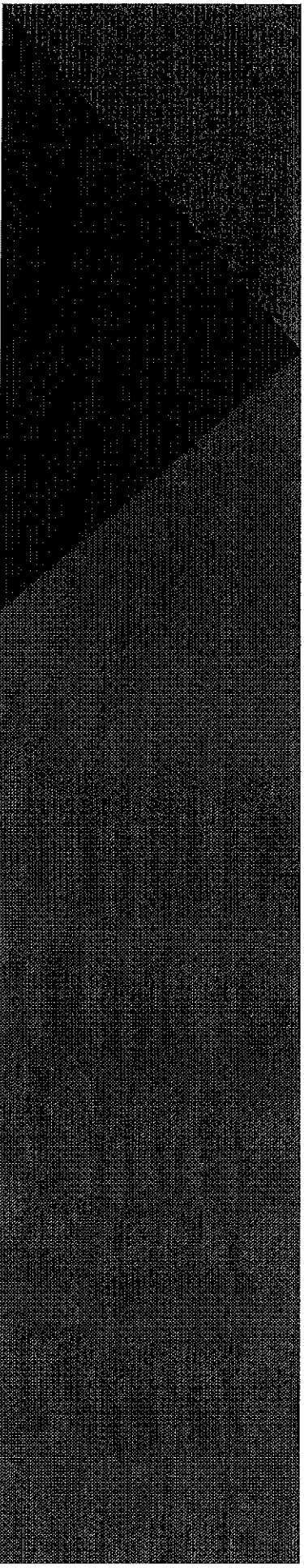




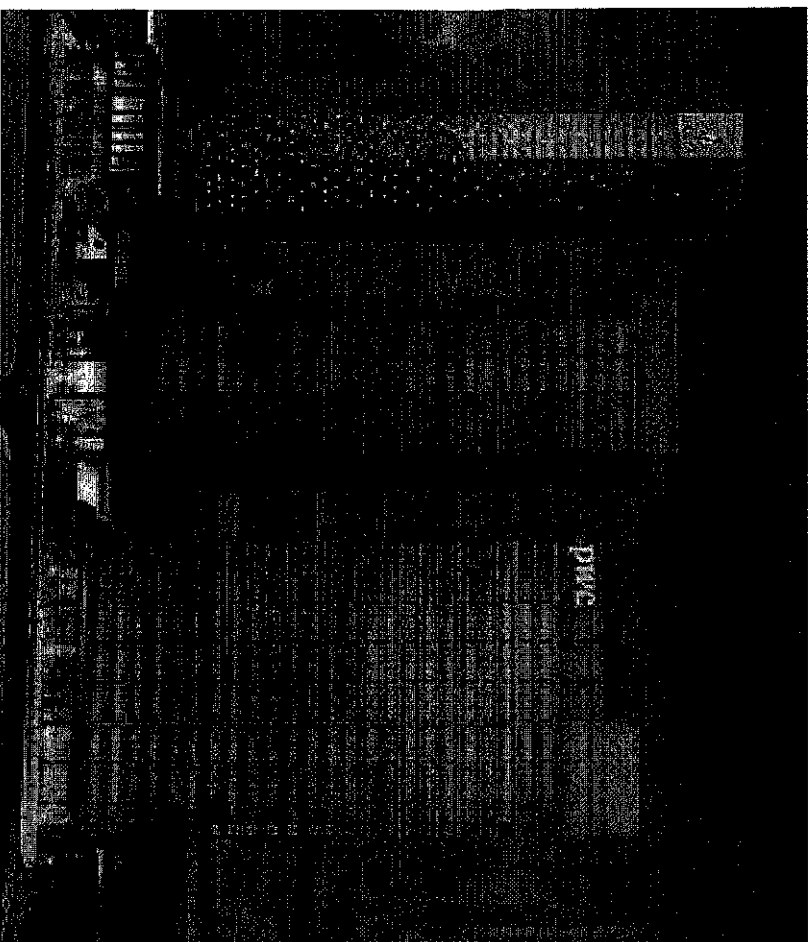
Home to two international airports, Toronto is easily accessible within North America and from most major cities worldwide.

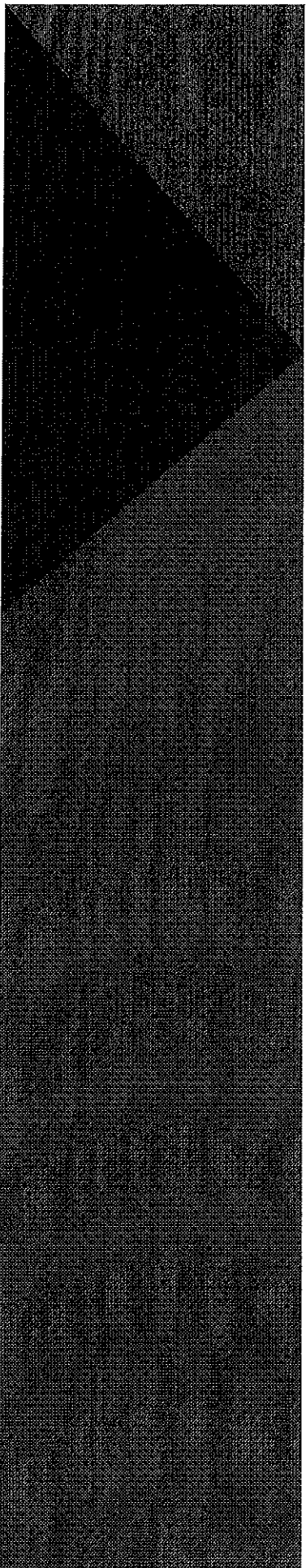


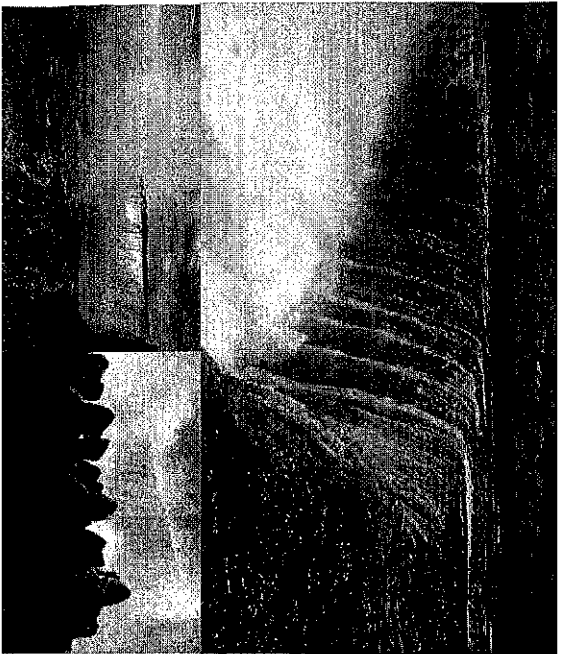
Funding
