A graduate of Emory University (BA, JD and MBA), Shayna frequently lectures and has authored many publications, including *The Family Lawyer's Guide to Bankruptcy*, which is published by the ABA Family Law Section and is in its 4th edition and she is a co-editor of the recently published: *Her Story: Lessons in Success from Lawyers Who Live It*, released by the ABA Litigation Section in the Summer of 2017; *Her Story 2: The Resilient Woman Lawyer's Guide to Conquering Obstacles*, released by the ABA Litigation Section in the Winter of 2023 and a contributing author to the *Georgia Business Litigation* (ALM, 2026).

Bruce practices family law and serves as Mediator and Guardian ad litem. Bruce is a Fellow of the American Academy of Matrimonial Lawyers ("AAML") and has practiced law for over 30 years. He received his J.D. from Emory University School of Law in 1988, earning an American Jurisprudence award in his jurisprudence class and serving as an editor of the *Emory Journal of International Dispute Resolution*. Bruce received his B.A. (in English and Philosophy) and M.A. (in Philosophy) from the State University of New York at Binghamton. He began his legal career in 1988 as Law Clerk for Judge Dorothy A. Robinson of Cobb County Superior Court. After working as a Shareholder in an Atlanta law firm, Bruce and his wife, Shayna, formed Steinfeld & Steinfeld in 2000. A frequent lecturer on family law-related topics at continuing legal education seminars both locally and nationally, Bruce served as Chair of the Family Law Section of the Atlanta Bar Association from 2004-2005. He has also served on the Family Law Section's Civil Rules Committee and as Editor of the Section's monthly newsletter, "The Family Lawyer." Bruce is a member of the Family Law Sections of the American Bar Association, State Bar of Georgia, and Atlanta Bar Association and is also a member of the Charles Longstreet Weltner Family Law Inn of Court. Bruce is currently the President of the Georgia Chapter of the AAML and he serves on the national board of the AAML Foundation.
